Consumers Credit Union Hosts 77th Annual Meeting, Election of Four Members to Board of Directors

Member-owners convene in Grayslake on March 14, 2007

Waukegan, IL, February 27, 2007: Consumers Credit Union (CCU) is proud to host its' 77th Annual Meeting on Wednesday, March 14, at the Country Squire Restaurant in Grayslake. The meeting is open to all Members of the credit union . . . and the agenda includes elections to fill four (4) positions on the Member-owned credit union's Board of Directors.

"Consumers Credit Union looks forward to welcoming Members to our 2007 Annual Meeting," noted Sean M. Rathjen, CCU President. "One of the rights in a Member-owned organization is to have a say in the credit union's governance and to vote for its Board. We have nine (9) highly-qualified candidates to serve three (3) year terms . . . and that number speaks to the active interest of our Members."

Rajceвич, Waukegan; Janice Taylor, Mundelein; and, Chris Ulrich, Pleasant Prairie.

Ballots will be counted and the election certified by CCU's CPA firm, Wipfli, Ullrich, Betelson LLP. The four (4) candidates with the highest number of votes will be notified to attend the Board Meeting on Thursday, March 22, 2007 at 6:00 p.m. at CCU's Main Office, to organize the new Board and for the election of Board officers for the coming year.

Approximately 300 Members are expected to attend the 77th Annual Meeting at the Country Squire Restaurant, 19133 West Highway 120, in Grayslake. Tickets are available for \$15 on a first-come, first served basis. Tickets can be purchased at all CCU branches; no tickets will be sold at the door.

Registration begins at 5:30 p.m., with dinner at 6:30 p.m., followed by a business meeting to inform members of CCU's 2006 financial status and the election of Board Members. Annual Reports for the credit union's 2006 business year will also be distributed at the meeting.
